The Lloyd Center is a BIG shopping mall. You can get to Lloyd Center in a car or on Max or you can ride the bus.

A nice thing about Lloyd Center is they have lots of places for people to sit. If you are feeling stressed out you can sit down for a little while. It is bright at the mall and noisy so sometimes it is good to sit down and relax.



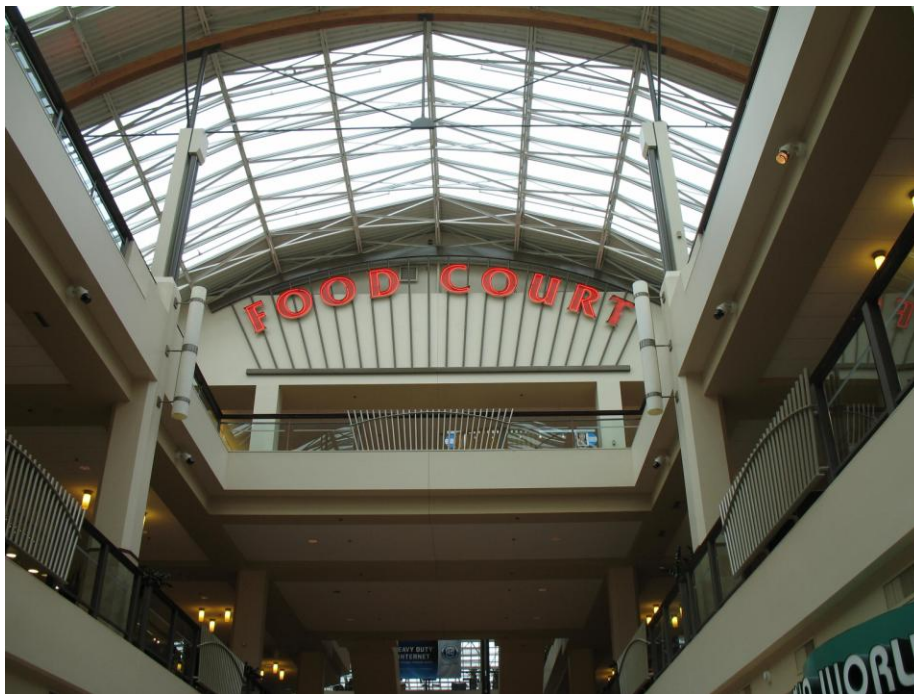
Some people like to use the elevators to go up or down. This guy is in a wheelchair so he and his friend are riding in the elevator. They stay together because they are a group.



Sometimes the elevator doors have signs on them. This elevator is by the food court.



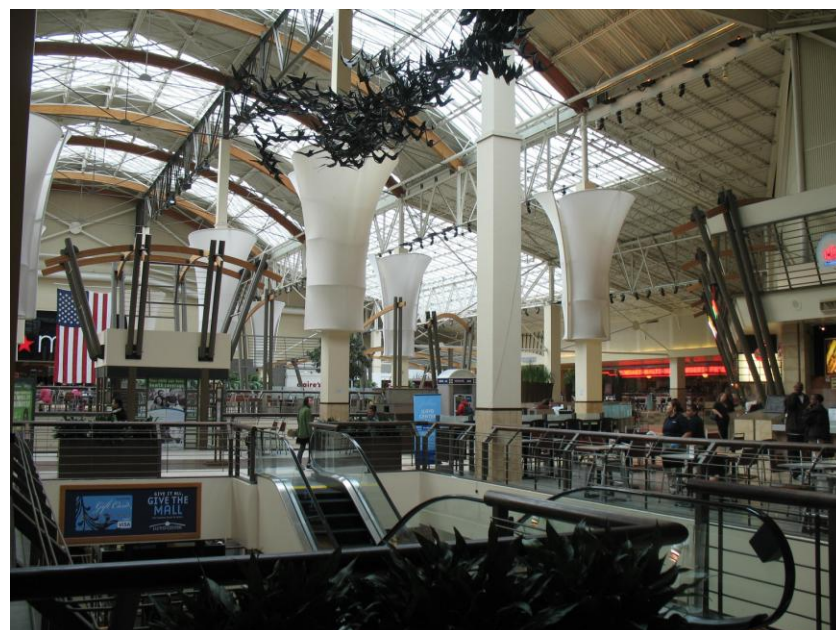
